CURRICULUM VITAE

Dr. Gordon has practiced Orthopedic Surgery in South Florida for over 51 years. During this 51+ years he has averaged 200 new patients per year. Up until now 10,000 cases total. In 2013 he saw 412 new patients bringing the current total to 10,412 cases.

His practice is now office only. His practice consists of Emergency Medical Determinations, Orthopedic consultations, evaluations, IMEs, and testifying in court. He has an exceptional record when testifying in court. Since Jan. 2011 he has won every case in which he testified.

Up until Oct. 2011 his office was on the grounds of Jackson North Medical Center where he remains an Active Community member in the Department of Orthopedic Surgery. The Jackson Memorial Hospital chain is the largest in Florida and the third largest in the United States. His experience with such a large volume of severe Orthopedic Emergencies at Jackson Memorial has been most valuable when he performs an Emergency Medical Determination.

ORTHOPEDIC TEACHING EXPERIENCE

From 2001 to 2006 Dr. Gordon taught Orthopedic Residents at his hospital and was a Clinical Instructor in the Department of Orthopedic Surgery at Nova Southeastern University. #### FELLOWSHIP RESEARCH

His year of research in Orthopedic Surgery was an attempt to visualize soft tissues in the body with an x-ray. In the current computer age this is now easily done with CT scans and MRI scans, but in 1962 powerful computers were not available. The results of the research were published in the American Journal of Radiology, and were exhibited at the meeting of the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons in Bal Harbour in January 1963.
